My name is Cheairs Porter, and I am a Special Assistant Attorney General. Because of the importance of this matter, the Attorney General forwarded me a copy of your December 22, 2009, electronic mail correspondence. I understand from the email that you are unhappy with the City of Chickasaw's apparent steps towards bringing gambling into the city. Please find attached herewith copies of the following documents and law that I hope will address your concerns:


1. October 6, 2009, letter to Mayor Bryan Pittman;
2. Alabama Constitutional Amendment No. 440; and
3. Alabama Act Nos. 83-731 & 93-710.

I regret that as an attorney for the State of Alabama I am unable to provide any legal advice to private citizens on legal matters. However, please feel free to keep this Office apprised of the status of gambling activity in your city. While the Attorney General places the primary responsibility for enforcing the gaming laws upon local law enforcement, he will take necessary steps to eliminate illegal gambling if local law enforcement refuses to take action. Therefore, I suggest as a starting point, you contact your local District Attorney, John Tyson, and report your concerns.
